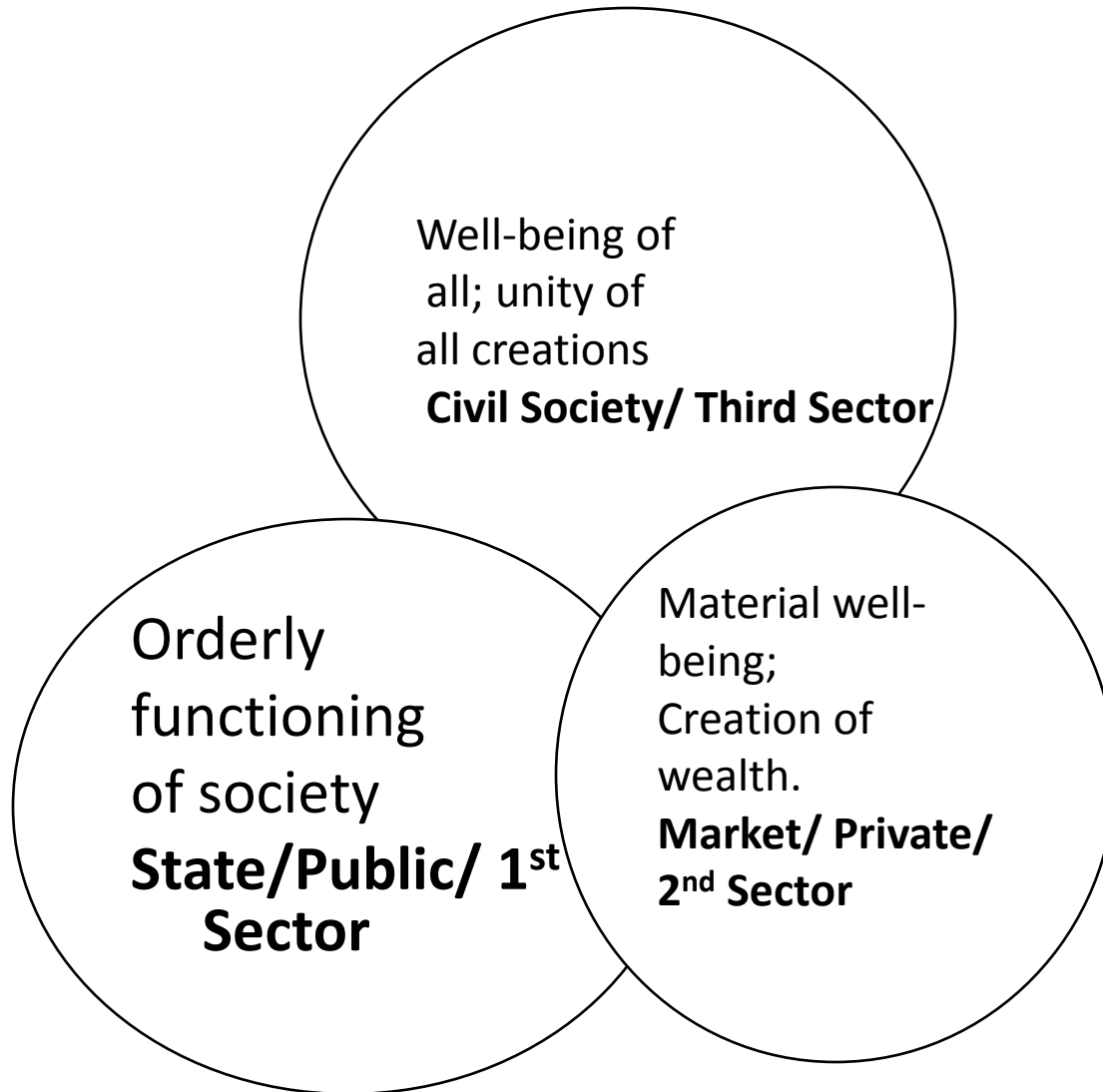

Evolution of Human Organisations

Three broad motivations spawn human organizations:

- Orderly conduct & growth of society
 - **the State or the Public Sector** → *the first sector*
 - *includes government, the judiciary, etc.*
- Material well-being through production and exchange
 - **the Market, the Private Sector** → *the second sector*
 - *includes business, industry, etc.*
- Transcendental concerns (well-being of all, charity, beyond me and mine/here and now, charity)
 - **Civil Society** → *the third sector*
 - *NGOs like PRADAN, cultural associations, etc.*

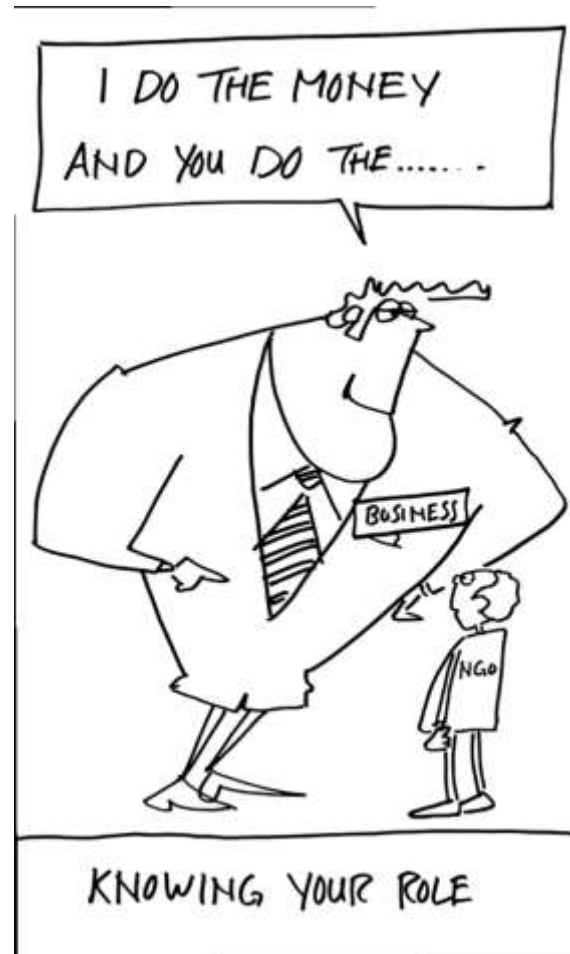
Partnerships: Key Insights
